IRB & RWC Drivers Needed

Sunday 10th May, 3.30pm-6.30pm, Mindil SLSC, Mindil Beach - You will be showing our visitors the capabilities of the IRB and RWC and the methods we use to rescue those in danger - many of our international visitors have no experience with these craft. It is intended the visitors will experience some crewing duties and be part of rescue scenarios. RWCs will need to be launched and recovered at the Ski Club Boat Ramp. We need a volunteer to transport the RWC based at Darwin Surf Club and another volunteer to transport the RWC based at SLSNT. Need 2-4 RWC Operators and 1 -2 IRB Drivers (use Mindil Beach IRB).

Saturday 16th May, 6.30am-12.30pm, Darwin SLSC, Casuarina Beach - This is the last day of Lifesaving competition in the Arafura Games. We need two IRBs to set up board and ski courses and the string of swim buoys at dawn. Need 2 IRB crews (use Darwin IRBs). Need 2-4 RWC Drivers.

Sunday 17th May, 8.00am-12noon, Darwin SLSC, Casuarina Beach - Long distance invitation events are being offered to Arafura Games visitors and all local members. On the water we will have a 2km board course and a 5 km ski course for single and double skis. Need 2 IRB crews and 2 RWC Drivers.
