Summary of this circular

This circular requests summary information on club patrol operations by Thursday 24 April 2008.

Clubs are requested to submit a summary of their Patrol Operations to Surf Life Saving Northern Territory on or before Thursday 24 April 2008. If the club has a 2008 Beach Management Plan then a copy of that document should be submitted.

Club patrols form an important part of the Total Lifesaving Service Plan required from SLSNT under the SLSA Strategic Management Plan 2007-2011 (ref B2.1).

As an essential lifesaving service to the local community all patrol operations should conform to relevant SLSA policies and manuals which are readily available from SLSNT or the SLSA website.

The Lifesaving Patrol Operations Summary is an important operational document for each club's patrolling lifesavers and it is suggested that it be displayed prominently in the clubrooms. This information is also referenced by SLSNT when dealing with key stakeholders, sponsors and the media.

To assist clubs a pro-forma plan has been drafted for each club and accompanies this circular. Clubs should amend the document as required and are welcome to discuss any aspect of the coming season's patrol operations with...
