These events will be contested in the following categories with competitors only permitted to enter one age division (ie there are no Open events):

Masters (40 and over)
Senior (19-39 years)
U/19 (17-18 years)
U/17 (15-16 years)
U/15 (13-14 years)

Points will be allocated

1st = 4 points 2nd = 3 points 3rd = 2 points Participation = 1 point

At the conclusion of the individual events selected relay events will be held.

*Wherever possible, carnival officials will endeavour to combine events for time efficiency.
It remains the competitor's responsibility to be aware of marshalling calls for their events.*

Surf Boat Racing

An Open Surfboat competition will be held over 3 rounds with the winning crew decided on points gained for places in each round.

Points will be allocated

1st = 4 points 2nd = 3 points 3rd = 2 points Participation = 1 point

A 'blind handicap' winner will be also be calculated from rowing times. The handicap will be based on a selected round and applied to the times in a different round. The selection of rounds is by ballot at the end of the competition. The blind handicap system means crews do not know which round the handicap will be based on, nor which round the handicap will be applied to.

Entries & Registration

Registered, financial members of a club affiliated with Surf Life Saving NT are eligible to enter. Competitors must register on-the-day before the start of competition. Surfboat crews need to nominate a crew name (eg Mindil Muddies, Darwin Green, Gove Crocs etc).
