Darwin Radio Repeater Tested

SLSNT's Darwin VHF Radio Repeater performed extremely well last weekend when a team of members tested its range and the readability of radio messages on the repeater channel - Channel R1. This channel is known as a duplex channel and operates through SLSNT-owned repeater hardware on the elevated Gardens Hill, approximately 1.5 km north of the Darwin CBD. The duplex channel is intended for

- o Interclub/intergroup communication.
- Extended range operations SAR missions, long distance events etc. Radios accessing duplex channels are capable of a range of more than 20 km from the repeater, depending on the height of the antenna, and the new SLSNT repeater gives very effective coverage of the Darwin Estuary which includes the rivers and creeks of the East, Middle and West Arms and the into the Beagle Gulf. Thanks to Craig Croke for the use of his boat and radio operators Jo Gardiner, Julie Snelling Sonia Marsh and Tony Snelling. Further testing to identify blind spots will be carried out by SAR Team members in April and May.
