Awesome performances in Kellogg's Nutri-Grain Ironman Series

Surf sports superstar Shannon Eckstein won Round 1 & 2 of the Kellogg's Nutri-Grain Ironman Series last weekend at Kurrawa Beach on the Gold Coast and showed why he will again be the man to beat this season. Shannon (Northcliffe SLSC) backed up Saturday's round one win with a powerhouse performance in Sunday's Accumulator races in an exact replica of the round one podium to finish well clear of Hugh Dougherty (Tugun SLSC) and four-time National Ironman champion, Olympian Ky Hurst (Kurrawa SLSC).

In the women's competition it's not so clear cut. WA's Alicia Marriott won Round 1 from Kristyl Smith and Hayley Bateup but in Round 2 it was Bateup, a three-time Coolangatta Gold winner who turned 30 last week, who took line honours. Showing age is no barrier she produced one of the most satisfying wins of her career with another near-perfect display of surf sports skills and leaving Kristyl and Alicia for 2nd and 3rd places.
